The challenge in this home, completed in 2014, was to design his-and-hers heated towel bars, reachable from inside the shower. The solution was to create symmetrically tiled recessed spaces flanking the shower door. Richly hued and textured Escarpement marble tile frames the entry to the shower; the tiles are miter-cut on all outside edges to avoid outside grout joints and give a sense of marble blocks rather than tile. Miter-cut application is applied throughout, from the wall-to-wall floating bench to the symmetrically inset tiled towel warmer niches.
